As part of the program Melvin Brown, the former choirmaster at Trinity on the Hill, was to sing a few Christmas Carols. I don't remember how many songs he sang or even which ones, with one exception. O Holy Night: which he sang a cappella. There is not a wordsmith alive who could describe how hauntingly beautiful was the marriage of his voice to that carol. And in that moment, I was given a gift greater than the sound of Melvin's voice. In that brief moment, I felt ... I knew, without an inkling of doubt, the existence of God. The peace of God.
