ALERT- COGS IS BACK FOR 2024!

Some of you may remember from the past the COGS volunteer efforts to provide needed services to community organizations reaching out to those in need. We will be starting back COGS for this year meeting on the 3rd Saturday of each month with opportunities for outreach by acting on the message of the Gospel.

Our first COGS will be on January 20th at Golden Harvest Food Bank, 3310 Commerce Drive, from 1-4pm. We will be packing food for the Backpack Program and the Senior Box Program. It is hard to realize that in our community 1 in 6 children suffer with hunger. Many of these children rely on school meals to get enough to eat during the school year. During weekends and holidays, they may receive little or nothing to eat at home. The Backpack Program provides schoolaged children in need with a bag full of healthy food and snacks each Friday so that they have enough to eat over the weekend. We will also be packing Senior Food Boxes. Many seniors in our area endure hunger in silence. After working their whole lives many seniors are now unable to work in the wake of a disability or chronic medical issues. Some find themselves alone and vulnerable faced with the choice between buying enough to eat or paying for medical care and housing. The Senior Food Box program provides senior adults in need with a monthly box of nutritious, meal-ready groceries.

If you are interested in volunteering for this much needed ministry please e-mail Lynn Tyson, ltyson517@gmail.com, with your name and contact information as well as the time you can work: 1-4pm, 1-2:30pm, or 2:30-4pm. Golden Harvest requires that people volunteering wear long pants, closed toe shoes and shirts with sleeves. Water will be provided and snacks when the task is finished.
