## **NOT YET!**

As I am sitting here in the midst of Holy Week, I want to be writing a piece for *The Shepherd's Fold* that begins: "He is Risen!," but that would be a tremendous disservice to Good Shepherd. It is true that Easter is the highpoint of the Christian year, and without Jesus' resurrection on that first Easter morning, there would be no Christian faith. As Paul says, if Jesus had not been raised, "we are of all people most to be pitied." (1 Cor. 15.18) However, the power of Easter rests first with Good Friday, and we must not skip over it to get to Easter.

Good Friday is the day that we learn how much God loves us: that the second person of the Godhead, the eternal Word, would empty himself, become a fully human being, suffer for us, and give his life for us, the very people who are crucifying him. That is truly love beyond measure. We cannot fully appreciate that love if we do not first recall that awful day, recall how humanity (that is us) shouted "crucify him," and hear how Jesus went to the cross on our behalf nonetheless. Good Friday, like no other day, humbles me, shames me, yet it also uplifts me knowing that Jesus did this out of love for me and all humanity. Only when I have gone to the depths of Good Friday am I fully prepared to celebrate Jesus' resurrection where the power of God's love defeats death itself.

We always have two services on Good Friday: noon and 7:00 PM. My prayer for you is that you will be present in church on Good Friday so that you may experience the joy of Easter as it is meant to be.
