WILL OUR DOGS BE IN HEAVEN?

Our beloved Shih Tzu Lily Belle now awaits us at the Rainbow Bridge. After brightening our lives for 13 years and 8 months, Lily left us suddenly, probably a victim of this strange lung disease in dogs that has appeared in our area. Even though we knew Lily's best days were behind her, the gut-wrenching pain of her unexpected death was terrible. All of you who have experienced the loss of a beloved pet know exactly what I'm talking about! Comfort is hard to find.

I find comfort in my answer to a question posed to me by a child many decades ago, "Will my dog go to heaven?" My answer was then and is now, yes, yes, and yes. I'll tell you why I believe that Lily and all my dogs will be in heaven. The answer is in scripture.

In the first creation story (Genesis 1:24-25), we are told that God created all the animals before humans and declared it was good! Obviously from the very beginning animals had an important role in God's plan.

Secondly, God included the animals in the covenant he made with Noah. "I now establish my covenant with you and with your descendants after you and with every living creature that was with you." (Genesis 9:9-10).

Thirdly, in the new creation, "the leopard will lie down with the goat, the calf and the lion and the yearling together, and a little child will lead them. The cow will feed with the bear, their young will lie down together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox." (Isaiah 11).

If you were to ask me to describe Lily in a single word, that word is love. When I consider the deep affection, love, and relationship I have had with Lily and all my dogs, I cannot believe that God would let that love disappear in death.

Paul says very clearly in Corinthians 13:8, "Love never ends!" So, if Lily was love and love never ends then Lily is in heaven waiting for me at the Rainbow Bridge.
